## Water

- Observe where water flows in your yard during rainy periods, identify moist and dry areas, and potential areas to capture water, including roofs, curbs, dry creeks, etc.
- Construct cisterns or tanks, use design that allows the first rain water to flush debris from roof.
- Learn how to use less water inside and outside, become water conscious, use shut off nozzle when watering plants, think about how long you need to run a faucet when washing dishes, etc.
- Install water saving devices, including - low flush toilets, drip lines, hose shut off nozzles.
- Remove lawns and replace with edible or drought tolerant plants.
- Store water for emergency electricity and water disruptions, get a bucket, and think about where you will get water if there is no water in the taps.
- Work with us in helping to change grey water regulations so that we can install systems to reuse grey water in and outside of our homes.
